This matter, having been opened by the Commissioner of Banking and Insurance (“Commissioner”), State of New Jersey, upon information that Javon L. Jones (“Respondent”), licensed as a resident insurance producer, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 17:22A-32, may have violated the insurance laws of the State of New Jersey; and

WHEREAS, Respondent is subject to the provisions of New Jersey Insurance Producer Licensing Act of 2001, N.J.S.A. 17:22A-26 et seq.; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 17:22A-40a (2), an insurance producer shall not violate any insurance laws, or violate any regulation, subpoena or order of the Commissioner or of another state’s insurance regulator; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 17:22A-40a (8), an insurance producer shall not use fraudulent, coercive or dishonest practices, or demonstrate incompetence, untrustworthiness or financial irresponsibility in the conduct of insurance business in this State or elsewhere; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 17:22A-40a (16), an insurance producer shall not commit any fraudulent act; and

WHEREAS, Respondent is currently employed as a New Jersey licensed bail bond agent with current licensee Boardwalk Bail Bonds; and

WHEREAS, Respondent, while attempting to serve a warrant to a New Jersey resident, verbally misrepresented himself as an employee of the "Fugitive Recovery Task Force" with the New Jersey Department of Banking and Insurance ("Department"), an entity which does not exist in New Jersey State government, in violation of N.J.S.A. 17:22A-40a (2), (8), and (16); and

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WHEREAS, the Respondent:

- 1) Has admitted responsibility for the aforementioned violations; and
- 2) Has cooperated with the investigation conducted by the Department; and

WHEREAS, this matter should be resolved upon the consent of the Parties without resort to a formal hearing; and

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS on this 1<sup>st</sup> day of June, 2016

ORDERED AND AGREED, that pursuant to N.J.S.A. 17:22A-40a, the Respondent consents to the revocation of his resident insurance producer license, Reference Number 1527369, and said license shall be immediately returned to the Department upon execution of this Consent Order by Respondent, and sent to the attention of:

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED AND AGREED, that pursuant to N.J.A.C. 11:17D-2.7, the Respondent is barred from reapplying for an insurance producer license for a period of five years from the date of the Commissioner's issuance of this Consent Order; and

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED AND AGREED that the provisions of this Consent Order represent a final agency decision and constitute a final resolution of the violations contained herein.
