ALAN CHADRJIAN : ORDER OF REVOCATION

This matter was opened by the Board of Examiners by way of an Order to Show Cause issued to Alan Chadrijan as to why his teaching certificates should not be revoked. Chadrijan currently holds a School Business Administrator Certificate of Eligibility, issued in May 1998 and a School Business Administrator certificate, issued in May 2000. Pursuant to *N.J.A.C. 6A:9-17.4*, the Cedar Grove Board of Education notified the Board of Examiners that Chadrijan, the School Business Administrator in the district, resigned from his position after it was alleged that he viewed sexually oriented pictures of young males on his district computer. After the teaching certification matter was transmitted to the Office of Administrative Law for hearing, Chadrijan presented a settlement proposal to the Board in which he would relinquish his certificates with the force and effect of a revocation and all attendant consequences pursuant to *N.J.A.C. 6A:9-17.8*. After reviewing the settlement proposal, at its meeting of July 28, 2011, the Board of Examiners voted to accept the proposal. Accordingly, on this 28th day of July 2011, Alan Chadrijan's School Business Administrator Certificate of Eligibility and his School Business Administrator certificate are hereby revoked effective immediately.
