DARRYL SEMPLE : ORDER OF REVOCATION

At its meeting of September 22, 2011, the State Board of Examiners reviewed an affidavit that the Hudson County Prosecutor's Office had submitted regarding Darryl Semple. After being charged with Forgery for submitting fake teaching certificates to a district in order to obtain employment, Semple was accepted into a Pretrial Intervention Program and was required to forfeit his legitimately-held teaching certificate as a condition of entering the program. Semple currently holds a Teacher of Elementary School Certificate of Eligibility, issued in December 1999.

Semple agreed to relinquish his certificate with the force and effect of a revocation and all attendant consequences in his affidavit to that effect to the New Jersey State Board of Examiners. At its meeting of September 22, 2011, the Board voted to accept Semple's relinquishment with the force and effect of a revocation pursuant to *N.J.A.C.* 6A:9-17.8.

Accordingly, on this 22nd day of September 2011 it is therefore ORDERED that the revocation of Darryl Semple's Teacher of Elementary School Certificate of Eligibility be effective immediately.
