## GENERAL GUIDELINES FOR SAFE SURF CHAIR USE

- Use of the surf chair is restricted to those individuals weighing less than two hundred seventy-five (275) pounds
- An attendant must be present when the chair is in use
- The attendant must not undertake tasks which exceed his/her physical ability
- At no time and under no circumstances is the surf chair to be placed in the water beyond a depth of six (6) inches.

- Ramps to the boardwalk at 21st, 22nd, 23rd, 24th, 26th, 27th, 29th, 30th and 32nd Streets
- Ramps to the beach at 8th Street and Avalon Avenue; from the boardwalk to the beach at 30th Street; and to an observation platform and to the beach at 80th Street
- Hard-packed gravel paths from street to beach are located at 32nd, 38th and 60th Streets
- Accessible bay front piers at 8th, 23rd, 24th, 33rd, 37th, 53rd, and 57th Streets

All side streets are metered, but free to properly marked accessible vehicles

- Reservations are strongly suggested
- Chairs may be signed out for 1-5 days; on the first day of a reservation, the chair(s) must be picked up by 11:30 am
- If chairs are kept for more than 1 day, you must provide your own storage and transportation

### ACCESSIBLE REST ROOMS

- Public rest rooms are located at 32nd, 40th, 44th on the beach and 94th Street at Townsend's Inlet Park
- All rest rooms have at least 1 accessible stall
- There are separate fully accessible rest rooms at 40th Street

### ACCESSIBLE PARKING

- There are accessible parking spaces along JFK Boulevard & Promenade
- Mostly metered parking

### ACCESS TO BOARDWALKS AND BEACHES

- Ramps (concrete) to the boardwalk at every street adjacent to the boardwalk
- Ramps to the beach at 1st, 3rd, Pennlyn Place, 4th, Brighton Place, 6th, 12th, Moornlyn Terrace, 13th, 14th, 40th, 46th, 52nd, 55th and 58th Streets
- Direct access to the beach at 23rd, 29th, 34th, 57th and Morningside Streets

### SURF CHAIRS

Locations:  
• Total of 50 surf chairs are available from Memorial Day through Labor Day
- 1 chair is available at each of the Lifeguard Stands at 1st, 12th, 34th and 59th Streets, to act as transport onto the beach
- The rest of the chairs are available for pickup (NO CHARGE) at the Sports & Civic Center at 6th Street & Boardwalk between 9 am and 5 pm

### Reservations:

- Reservations are encouraged; to reserve a chair, contact the Recreation Division at the Sports & Civic Center (609-525-9304) between 9 am and 5 pm
- Surf chairs can be reserved for up to 2 weeks or can be used on a daily basis
- Failure to pick up the chair within 24 hours of the initial reservation date will result in the cancellation of your reservation
- Both child and adult size chairs are offered

### ACCESSIBLE REST ROOMS

- Accessible rest rooms are located on the Music Pier at 9th Street & Boardwalk
- All other public rest rooms are accessible

### ACCESSIBLE PARKING

- There is NO CHARGE for the parking lot located at 5th Street & Asbury Avenue
- 9th Street & New Haven Street
- There is NO CHARGE for on-street parking for properly marked accessible vehicles
- Municipal parking lots provide accessible parking for a CHARGE

- At Cresse Avenue (beyond boardwalk), there is direct access to the beach
- Beach Patrol will provide transport from the boardwalk onto the soft sand for person with disabilities and 1 companion after 11 am and will provide return transport to the boardwalk before 4 pm

### SURF CHAIRS

• There are a total of 3-4 chairs available
- All are located at the Beach Patrol Headquarters at Lincoln Avenue & Ocean
- There is NO CHARGE for use of chairs

### Reservations:

- Chairs are available on a first come, first served system
- Reservations are strongly encouraged (609-522-8258 or 609-846-2054)
- Chairs may be reserved for more than 1 day at a time, but must be returned each night and must stay at all times in Wildwood on the beach
- 2 forms of ID are required to reserve chairs

### ACCESSIBLE PARKING

- Available on at least every other street at Ocean
