Seven \$10,000 New Jersey Lottery Tickets Sold as the Powerball Jackpot Rolls to \$400,000,000

TRENTON (February 18, 2014) – There were seven \$10,000 third prize New Jersey Lottery tickets sold that matched four white balls and the Powerball for the Saturday, February 15 drawing. Two of the third prize tickets were purchased in Bergen County: one at A & P, 45 De Mercurio Dr., Allendale and another at Rochelle Park Liquors, 332 Rochelle Ave., Rochelle Park. The other five \$10,000 winning tickets were bought at the following locations: Burlington County at Shoprite of Route 38 & Ark Road, 127 Ark Rd., Mt. Laurel; Hudson County at Tully’s Shoprite Liquor, 98 Passaic Ave., Kearny; Monmouth County at West Long Branch BP, 133 Highway 36, West Long Branch; Ocean County at Sunoco #7188, 2 No. County Line Rd., Jackson; and Salem County at Pennsville News Shop #1, 233 No. Broadway, Pennsville.

In addition to the third prize winning tickets, there were 64,366 New Jersey players who took home an estimated \$372,025 in prizes ranging from \$4 to \$300, according to Lottery Executive Director Carole Hedinger. The jackpot for the Wednesday, February 19 drawing is now \$400,000,000.

“Congratulations to these fortunate lottery players who purchased the winning tickets,” said Hedinger. “These lucky players now join the growing ranks of New Jersey Powerball winners.”

The winning numbers for the Saturday, February 15 drawing were: 02, 09, 14, 21 and 23. The Red Power Ball number was 03. The Multiplier number was 03.

The Powerball jackpot will roll to \$400,000,000 for the next drawing to be held Wednesday, February 19 at 11:00 pm.
