It's Snowing Winners at the New Jersey Lottery *Million Dollar Replay Winners Claim Their Cash Prizes*

TRENTON, NJ – (February 21, 2014) – The New Jersey Lottery added lots of green to the typically red heart and flower adornments on February 14th when it held the 2013 *Million Dollar Replay* Grand Prize Drawing. After the live drawing, the 15 top prizewinners were telephoned and informed of the news. Some of the calls were initially met with skepticism but once the recipients felt confident in the news, some shed tears but ultimately their excited laughter led to gratitude. The top three winners were invited to Lottery Headquarters on February 18th to claim their prizes.

On Feb. 18, after a morning of snow shoveling and slow moving traffic, the Lottery Headquarters was abuzz. Carole Hedinger, Lottery Executive Director said, “It is snowing winners here at the Lottery. I am always thrilled to give away top prizes – it’s the best part of my job.” Sandra Brodbeck had good reason to be excited as the winner of the million dollar Grand Prize. She was joined by the two \$100,000 winners, Jerry Pavlick and Edith Spruill. It was a party atmosphere as the winners were greeted by Executive Director Hedinger and John Custodio, Lottery Deputy Executive Director.

Sandra Brodbeck from Trenton said that she has participated in the Million Dollar Replay program since it began in 2011. She was chosen as a First Quarter Semi-finalist based on an entry comprised of two \$5 Massive Cash tickets. When Brodbeck recalled the phone call from the Lottery she said, "I didn't think it was real. I thought my friends were playing a joke on me." Brodbeck plans on replacing her 2001 car with a new SUV. She will also pay off her mortgage. "This is changing my life and I'm going to sleep a lot better now!"

Jerry Pavlick from Bloomfield said that the St. Jude charity will benefit from his win because his family has been adversely affected by cancer. As an active member of his church, Pavlick will also provide a donation to them. "I'm 76 years old, so a lot of stuff doesn't excite me anymore. I used to go sky diving and was a paratrooper in the 82nd Airborne Division." Pavlick said that he will "find something to do with it and then invest the rest." Pavlick was a semi-finalist in the Fourth Quarter of the game with a Big Money Spectacular ticket entry.

Edith Spruill from Piscataway found out she was finalist from the First Quarterly drawing on April 3rd, a day before her birthday. She is the proud grandmother of a 10 month old. Spruill said that she will donate some money to her church and invest a little and live comfortably.

Those winners that we were unable to reach by phone may have discovered their good fortune by reading their names on the New Jersey Lottery website's Million Dollar Replay Winner's Page. Additionally, they will all receive a letter in the mail confirming the drawing outcome.

New Jersey Lottery players can enter the current 2014 *Million Dollar Replay* program by joining the free New Jersey Lottery VIP Club accessible from the NJLottery.net website. Once a VIP Club member, players are qualified to enter their non-winning, eligible, instant game ticket numbers into the drawing. The current quarterly drawing entry period will end on March 31, 2014 with the drawing being held on or about April 3, 2014.

ABOUT THE MILLION DOLLAR REPLAY PROGRAM

The year-long *Million Dollar Replay* program offers players a second chance to win one of 15 top cash prizes by entering eligible, non-winning tickets that, prior to the initiation of the program, were simply thrown in the trash. Instant game players have the opportunity to win the Grand Prize Drawing by entering into one or more of the quarterly semi-finalist drawings. The quarterly drawing winners then populate the finalist pool for the grand prize drawing.

Each entry into the Million Dollar Replay program requires \$10 in non-winning instant game tickets, that are included in the games eligible list posted on the Lottery website. The \$10 amount may be accumulated by combining tickets with purchase prices ranging from \$1 up to \$20.
